1. **Ordinance 2018-08-01** – Second reading of an Ordinance of the Crestview Hills City Council adopting the Real Property Tax Rate for the City of Crestview Hills for tax year 2018 at .165 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
2. **Ordinance 2018-08-02** – Second reading of an Ordinance of the Crestview Hills City Council amending Section 95.21 of the Crestview Hills Code of Ordinances providing for a waste collection and recycling fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) per year for all residential properties and authorizing the Mayor to place this fee on the annual property tax bill.
3. **Ordinance 2018-08-03** – Second Reading of an Ordinance of the Crestview Hills City Council amending Section 110.04 of the Crestview Hills Code of Ordinances to increase the occupational license fee (Payroll Tax) levied and imposed to one and fifteen one-hundredths percent (1.15%) of the gross annual salaries, wages, or compensation earned in the City, subject to existing exclusions and exemptions, and eliminating redundant language, effective January 1st, 2019.
