

- Crestview Hills is a suburban community of Cincinnati with [6 neighborhoods](#).

- Conveniently located along **Interstate 275**, next to the **I-275/I-71 & I-75 Interchange** and **7 minutes from Northern Kentucky/Greater Cincinnati Airport (CVG)**.
- The City offers **free waste collection and curbside recycling** through [Rumpke](#).
- There is **no** city motor vehicle tax.
- The Transit Authority of Northern Kentucky (TANK) has [3 bus routes](#) throughout Crestview Hills.
- Crestview Hills offers the [lowest tax rates](#) compared to surrounding cities.
- There are two private [recreational facilities](#) for residents.
- The [Crestview Hills Town Center](#) offers over 40 stores and over 15 restaurants.
