

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE  
MEETING MINUTES  
Wednesday, June 1, 2022  
9:00 A.M.**

**Staff Present:** City Administrator Alex Mattingly, Public Works Director John Scheben, City Engineer Mike Yeager

Chairperson Tim McKinley called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. and led the Committee in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item considered was approval of the May 4, 2022 meeting minutes. Genie Wambaugh motioned to approve and Carol Sprinkle seconded, all voting in favor.

**Continuing Business**

A. Turkeyfoot Road Improvement Project – Mr. McKinley stated that the City has arranged an appointment with KYTC Deputy Secretary Mike Hancock to discuss the current project plan, and to suggest alternatives. Mike Yeager will get update on the project from Mike Bezold at KYTC.

B. Upcoming Roadwork, Shinkle Rd. and Summit Repaving – The Summit Lane work is on track to be out to bid on or about June 17, 2022; delays to the Shinkle Rd. work are still being caused by storm sewer design issues.

C. I-275 Noise Study (western Lookout Farm) – No update at this time.

D. Horsebranch Rd. Sidewalks – With the assistance of CT Consultants, the joint Crestview Hills and Edgewood grant applications for SNK Fund grants will be filed with the OKI Regional Council of Governments on or before June 3, 2022.

E. Dixie Hwy. Sidewalk Improvements (Whitehouse Drive to North City Boundary with Lakeside Park) – Mr. Yeager suggested pursuing SNK grant funds for this project. Mr. Lehman made the motion to pursue grant funds for this project and Ms. Wambaugh seconded, all voting in favor.

**Staff Report**

A. Mr. Scheben reported that the City has contracted with Riegler Blacktop to complete crack sealing on 12 streets – the work is to be completed in the next month or two.

- B. Mr. Yeager provided his recommendations for a crosswalk and raised median on Thomas More Parkway, to be located east of the entrance to Villa Madonna Drive, for Thomas More University students and staff to safely cross this roadway.
